Old Business

1. Strategic Planning
 - Mr. Gibson reviewed with the Cabinet ideas for the Strategic Planning process.
 - Mr. Gibson will work with Dr. Cederholm on completing a draft of an updated plan and then share the draft for feedback.
2. Enrollment Update
 - Dr. Exley led discussion on the DAX enrollment trend data he distributed to the Cabinet on Tuesday.
 - As of today, the College still needs over 300 credit hours for enrollment to be the same as last spring.
3. McCain Update
 - The College received notice last Friday that the Chancellor signed off on the construction plan, which went back to the Alabama Division of Construction Management (formerly the Alabama Building Commission). The DCM sent a letter for the College to proceed with the project.
 - Fencing will start to go up around the McCain Building next week. Then the demolition of the interior will be begin after that.
