Old Business

1. Strategic Planning
 - Deferred. No discussion.
2. Enrollment Update
 - Dr. Exley reported when he and Mr. Roden checked Spring enrollment this morning, enrollment was at 4,788 credit hours. The final paid credit hours enrollment for the first day of last Spring registration was 3,532.

1. Policy 608.01 – Instructor Load and Hours (Dr. Cederholm)
 - Dr. Cederholm reviewed the policy with the Cabinet.
 - The policy and procedures were developed for increasing slightly the faculty pay for independent studies for more incentive for faculty to oversee an independent study.
 - The Cabinet voted and unanimously approved the proposed policy and procedures.
