Old Business

1. Return to Work Plans/Reopening the College
 - Mr. Whitmore, Dr. Cederholm, and Mr. Cannon met on Monday to discuss plans involving Instruction and Student Services.
 - The plan is based on a color coding system with the College's current status identified as yellow.
 - All events have been cancelled until Aug. 1, but it's anticipated that this restriction may be extended.
 - Students coming to campus will be required to wear face coverings and observe social distancing.
 - Most on campus classes will revert to virtual where students will log into Blackboard Collaborate at the same days and times they would have attended their face-to-face class. A few career tech classes that require hands-on labs will be hybrid classes.
 - No face-to-face classes will be held after the Thanksgiving break. After Thanksgiving, all course work will be completed online.
 - Only essential travel will be approved. Out-of-state and international travel are prohibited.
 - All meetings will be held remotely.
 - The dorm will not open for fall, and there is a possibility the cafeteria will not need to open.

New Business

1. ASPIRE 2030 Strategic Plan

- ASPIRE 2030 is a strategic planning project through the Alabama Community College System in response to a \$1.2 billion bond issue in an effort to maximize the resources.
- The College will form a committee of internal and external stakeholders to complete the first phase of self-analysis.
- Sub-committees will be appointed from the committee recommendations to address each part of the self-analysis: Community Development, Community Engagement, Economic Development, Workforce Development and Adult Education, Finance, Management, Technology and Facilities, Learning and Student Success.
- Cabinet members are to submit two to three names in each category of stakeholders to the President's Office by noon on Monday.
