Amount of Funding Received

Snead State Community College acknowledges that the institution received **\$619,599** from the U.S. Department of Education on May 2, 2020 for the Student Portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Amount of Funding Distributed or Obligated

As of June 30, 2020, Snead State Community College disbursed \$619,599 of the Student Portion of the HEERF funds providing emergency financial aid grants to students.

Detailed List of Activities/Projects

Dorm students were required to vacate the dorm due to the COVID-19 closure. Dorm students received a pro-rated refund based on the number of weeks remaining in the spring semester. Sixty students were issued pro-rated refunds totaling \$40,827

Students with board tickets received a pro-rated refund based on the number of weeks remaining in the spring semester. Sixty students were issued pro-rated refunds totaling \$22,920.

The remainder of the CARES student emergency aid was disbursed to eligible students as technology grants. 979 students were issued a check for \$567.78 for a total of \$555,852.00.
