



Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you for your interest in the Nursing Program at Snead State Community College. Enclosed you will find the information necessary to apply for admission into our program.

Students meeting minimum admission standards may apply for admission to the Associate Degree Nursing program.

MINIMUM ADMISSION STANDARDS INCLUDE

- Admission to Snead State Community College
- Good standing with Snead State Community College
- Receipt of completed application packet by the deadline
- A minimum GPA of 2.50 (calculated based on grades earned in Pre-Nursing General Education courses)
- A minimum of 2.50 cumulative high school GPA for students without prior college work (GED acceptable)
- Eligibility for ENG 101 and MTH 100 (College Algebra) as determined by College policy
- Ability to meet essential functions/technical standards required for nursing
- ACT composite score of 18 or higher



To be considered for admission, a completed application packet must be received either by mail or hand delivery to the Department of Health Sciences prior to the deadline. Applications sent by mail must be postmarked by the deadline. **No application packets will be accepted after the extended deadline.**

DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION PACKETS

Priority Deadline: 5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 1, 2022.

Extended Deadline: 5 p.m. on Monday, May 16, 2022.

APPLICATION PACKETS

A completed application packet consists of

- Nursing Program application
- Transcripts for **all** prior college work attempted
 - For example, if you have attended a total of three colleges, you must submit all three transcripts.
 - Unofficial copies will be accepted for nursing application purposes.
 - Due to student confidentiality guidelines, the Nursing Department **will not** request transcripts from the Office of Student Services. **Therefore, only transcripts attached to your application will be evaluated for admission.** (SSCC students can print their Snead State transcripts online through their OneACCS account | snead.edu/oneaccs)
- High School transcripts (*required only for students with no previous college work*)
- A copy of ACT composite score of 18 or higher (*No expiration on ACT scores for nursing application purposes*)

*A completed application includes all of the applicable items listed above.
Applications will not be considered if they aren't complete with all of the required documentation.*

In addition to submitting completed application packets by the deadline, students must also apply for general admission to Snead State prior to the nursing application packet deadline. | snead.edu/admissions
You may contact the Health Sciences Office at nursing@snead.edu to confirm that your file is complete prior to the deadline.
