



Snead State Community College Registered Nursing Program Application

MINIMUM ADMISSION STANDARDS INCLUDE

- Unconditional admission to Snead State Community College with clear academic standing
- ACT composite score of 18 or higher
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 (calculated based on grades earned in Pre-Nursing core courses)
- Minimum of 2.5 cumulative high school GPA for students without prior college work (GED acceptable)
- Eligibility for ENG 101 and MTH 100 (College Algebra) as determined by College policy
- Ability to meet essential functions/technical standards required for nursing
- Receipt of completed application packet by the deadline

APPLICATION PACKET

A completed application packet consists of

- Nursing Program application
- A copy of ACT composite score of 18 or higher (*ACT Superscores not accepted*)
- Individual transcripts for **all** prior college work
 - For example, if you have attended a total of three colleges, you must submit all three transcripts.
 - Courses transferred from one college appearing on another college transcript are not accepted as proof of coursework
 - Unofficial copies of transcript(s) and ACT composite score are accepted for nursing application purposes.
 - **Only transcripts attached to your application will be evaluated for admission.**

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Priority Deadline: 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 1, 2023.

Extended Deadline: 4:00 p.m. on Monday, May 15, 2023.

No application packets will be accepted after the extended deadline.

To be considered for admission, a completed application packet must be received either by mail or hand delivery to the SSCC Department of Health Sciences prior to the deadline. Applications sent by mail must be postmarked by the deadline. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Students must also apply for general admission to Snead State and be unconditionally admitted prior to the nursing application deadline. You may contact the Health Sciences Office at nursing@snead.edu to confirm that your application is complete prior to the deadline. ***Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance into the program. Qualified applicants will be rank-ordered and only a predetermined number will be selected.***
