

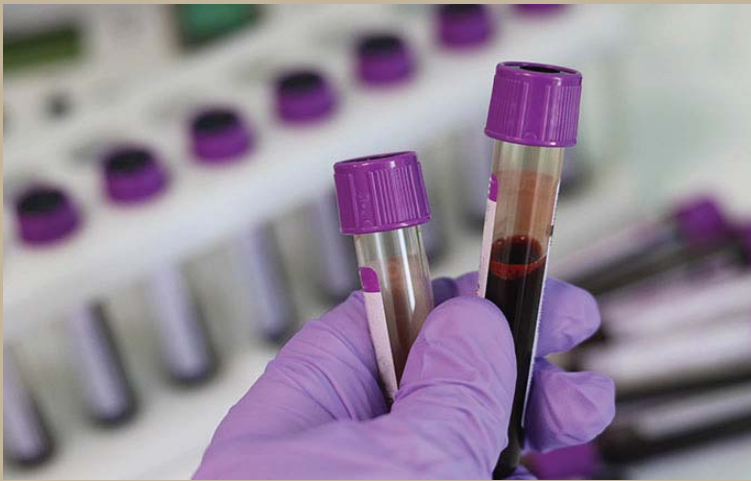

# Phlebotomy Technician

This comprehensive program is designed to allow students to become as a Phlebotomy Technician. Students will be prepared to collect blood specimens from clients for the purpose of laboratory analysis & become familiar with all aspects related to blood collection & develop comprehensive skills to perform venipunctures completely & safely. Classroom & lab work includes terminology, anatomy, physiology; blood collection procedures; specimen hands-on practice; BLS for Healthcare training & clinical training in skills & techniques to perform puncture methods. In addition to classroom hours, the program includes on-site clinicals - which is required for certification for phlebotomists. Upon completion of the program, students will obtain an National Career Readiness Certificate (CRC) & sit for the Certified Phlebotomy Tech (CPT) exam given through NHA (National Healthcareer Association).
