Thank you for your interest in the Adult Nursing Assistant Program at Snead State Community College (SSCC). Students meeting minimum admission standards of SSCC may apply for admission to the Adult Nursing Assistant Program. Registration with the Albertville Career Center is required. The Adult Nursing Assistant Program is a two-semester program. During the first semester (Fall), course content and testing will be provided online. Skills lab will be taught in the Robert Aderholt Health Science Building at Snead State Community College in Boaz, AL. Attendance is required. During the second semester (Spring), clinical will be taught at a long-term care facility. When the program is completed, students qualify to take the exam to be a Certified Nursing Assistant. Applications for the Adult Nursing Assistant Program are accepted and must be mailed between May 15th and June 15th. To be considered for admission, a completed application packet must be postmarked no later than **June 15th**. No application packets will be accepted after the deadline.

Short-Term Certificate
Location: Boaz Campus**

The Nursing Assistant/Home Health Aide short certificate program provides the student with the necessary theory, laboratory, and clinical experiences for the development of skills required to qualify as a long-term care Nursing Assistant/Home Health Aide. Emphasis is placed on the acquisition of skills in communication, observation, safety, mobility/body mechanics, personal and restorative care, and infection control necessary to care for patients and clients of all ages. Upon completion of the certificate program, students may apply for certification with the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP) and take the NNAAP examination. Students that have completed the certificate must pass both the written and skills portions of the NNAAP examination in order to be certified and listed on the Alabama Nurse Aide Registry.
