

LPN to RN Mobility
Program Information
Snead State Community College

The Snead State LPN to RN Mobility Program is a hybrid program (not an online program). Most of the theory content is presented online. However, students are required to attend several all-day labs during NUR 209. Students are also required to attend a minimum of one simulation each semester at a scheduled time. A minimum of one test each semester will be given requiring campus attendance. In addition, group clinical hours with a Clinical Instructor are required for NUR 209 & NUR 211. All Associate Degree Nursing students must complete a 180-hour preceptorship in NUR 221.

Applications to the program are available between August 1 and October 1 each year

To be considered for admission, a completed application packet must be received by mail or hand delivery to the Department of Health Sciences by 4:00pm on October 1st.

MINIMUM ADMISSION STANDARDS INCLUDE

- Unconditional admission to Snead State Community College
- Good standing with Snead State Community College
- Receipt of completed application packet by 4:00pm on October 1
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 (Calculated based on grades earned in Pre-Nursing General Education courses)
- Completion of ENG 101, MTH 100 (College Algebra or higher), BIO 201, BIO 202, SPH 106 or 107 and PSY 210 with a grade of “C” or higher
- Meeting the essential functions or technical standards required for Nursing
- ACT composite score of 18 or higher
- Unencumbered Alabama LPN license
